Vineyard

Spikey Bridge Vineyard is situated in Relbia,12km south of Launceston, just below the convict built Kerry Lodge Bridge, or Spikey Bridge. Soils are brown loam and clay over ancient dolerite rock.

VINTAGE

Spring was cool and wetter than average, leading to slightly delayed flowering and moderate crop levels. The season finished warm and relatively dry in the Tamar Valley, producing fresh, lifted fruit characters

WINEMAKING

A small portion of whole clusters is added to small batch, open-top fermenters, spending a total of 13 to 14 days on skins. Pressed once dry, a portion is aged in barrel with the remainder left in stainless steel tank to retain freshness
