NV Chardonnay Pinot Noir Adelaide Hills

VINEYARD

Sourced from a single vineyard in the Adelaide Hills from the outskirts of Gumeracha. The Chardonnay is East facing VSP managed I10V1 and produces crisp citrus notes with hints of stonefruit while the Pinot is North Facing D5V12 and produces fresh strawberry notes with hints of savouriness.

WINERY

Machine harvested, destemmed but not crushed straight to airbag press and dejuiced to tank. Fined and settled for 72 hours, then racked to ferment. A Neutral yeast strain was used for ferment then the wine left on yeast lees for 4 months to build mouth feel and texture. Secondary ferment was done in a pressure tank over two weeks and bottled early to preserve the crisp refreshing characters.

COLOUR

Brilliant clarity with pale golden straw and a slight salmon hue, persistent fine bead.

BOUQUET

The nose is complex with nectarine, peaches, citrus zest, green apple and quince with a hint of fresh strawberries.

PALATE

The palate is balanced and lively with delicate fruit characters of peach, green apple and nectarine with subtle melon notes and a hint of mild sweetness. The crisp fruit driven palate finishes with a savoury edge displaying hints of freshly baked bread and a refreshing strawberries and cream note. Delicate yet full flavoured palate with great fruit weight, intensity and length.
